THE NEO-CLASSICAL COLLECTION

THE REGENCY COLLECTION

THE GOTHIC REVIVAL COLLECTION

...draws on the leading style of the 1830s and 1840s, based on the study of Medieval buildings and decorative objects. The colours in this collection are noticeably rich and vibrant, drawn from Medieval decorative motifs which would have been used in fabrics and ceramics.

THE VICTORIAN ECLECTIC COLLECTION

...draws on the eclecticism of late Victorian taste, due in part to the developing trade links which brought into Britain exotic goods from the four corners of the globe. These influences are reflected in this harmonious collection which is characterised by heavily saturated colours.

THE ARTS & CRAFTS COLLECTION

...draws on the popular elegant style of the 1920s and 1930s. Inspired by the Exposition Internationale des Arts Décoratifs et Industriels held in Paris in 1925, the collection conveys an image of elegant luxury.
